

#### STUDENT MOBILITY GAP



"Europe has a great deal to offer in the field of higher education and scientific research, yet the great majority of Asian students studying abroad tend to go to North America or Australasia as a first priority. Equally, the number of European academics or students with links to Asia remains very small, while European Studies remains an underdeveloped field in most Asian countries".





#### CONCLUSIONS



- There are plenty of fascinating dynamics and multiple people-to-people encounters taking place far away from the discussion rooms of ASEM working groups, high-level meetings and ASEM or ASEF labelled activities.
- Online encounters grow in importance as facilitators of meetings and consultations among individuals residing in ASEM partner countries (and elsewhere). Joint training events offer shared familiarity with certain concepts and terminology that spans beyond the ASEM agreed language.
- Post-ASEM ME5: Riga is a good example that the implicit spirit of ASEM lives on thanks to the circulation of talent. Further exploration of how ASEM might benefit from this favourable intellectual environment would be one of the suggestions for the way forward.
