


ASTP in short


The role of Universities

- Universities three missions
 - Education
 - Reserach
 - Utilization
- Equally important hence 1/3 in budget for utilization as a national average
- Impact needs to be planed for but also need the supporting structures
 - Utilization is the key process for impact creation



Building Infrastructure for impact

- Need to restructure the university completely
- University based programs important part of this





Defining the profession

- Current trend in widening the scope of activities
- Needs to be reflected in definition
- Note that there is no less professionality in a particular position just because that is not the profession
 - A licensing specialist is a professional, but there is no profession for this specialization
 - A tech transfer specialist (commercial part) is a professional, but there is <u>no profession</u> for this specialization
 - A society for tech transfer professionals (NetVal, AUTM, ASTP, PA, RC, RO, SNITTS, ...) is a professional society, but there is <u>no profession</u> for this specialization
- If we are going to have success we need to be core business, i.e. the profession is the "utilizer" (bad word)
- It should encompass all our specializations
- It should be defined by us



Definition of the concept Profession

"A paid occupation, especially one that involves prolonged training and a formal qualification."

Profession is a term of a group with some common features. Among these features is delineation with other occupational groups, possessing special knowledge, tasks that contain unique or varied moments, independence and a special code of conduct.



The role of ASTP

- Defining the profession is our responsibility since
 - We represent a large chunk of the market and know how
 - Our task is to support our members as well as the wider community
 - We have the connections to the world wide community and can ascertain that it will matter



A collaborative, creative endeavour that translates knowledge and research into impact in society and the economy.

- With input from the 17 members of ATTP



Why important for the community?

- Gives a foundation for claiming space and role
- Ascertains credibility for the role
- Save universities from making a complete fool of themselves
 - Failing in impact and utilization



Certification of professionals

- Process partly in place in a restricted context via ATTP
 - Scope being adjusted
- Addition development for a true profession is work in progress (hopefully)
 - Professional certification requires some additional processing
- Possibilities for bachelor and masters programs in the future?
