Food Fraud Cases

A crackdown on counterfeit alcohol, codenamed "Operation Çengel-17", has resulted in the arrest of 28 individuals and the seizure of 98 600 l of adulterated ethyl alcohol. The alcohol had been disguised with "Surface Cleaner" labels and distributed across four provinces in Turkey, centred around Bursa. The operation aimed to prevent the deaths of hundreds of people due to consumption of counterfeit alcohol. 01/03/2025 haberler

Authorities in Côte d'Ivoire have seized 75 tonnes of cocoa intended for smuggling. The operation aims to combat tax evasion and protect the national economy. 05/03/2025 afrique-sur

Sri Lankan authorities have seized a stock of contaminated wheat flour after detecting high levels of mould and other contaminants. The operation aims to protect public health and prevent the distribution of adulterated food products. 06/03/2025 srilankamirror

Bolivian authorities have seized a large quantity of smuggled food and fuel, valued at nearly EUR 510 000. The operation was carried out in different parts of the country and confiscated products such as oil, rice, sugar, flour and fuel. 14/03/2025 elpais

Gauteng police in South Africa have seized a large quantity of counterfeit alcohol, valued at over EUR 45 000. Two people have been arrested in connection with the case. The operation was carried out in an effort to combat the production and distribution of illegal alcohol in the region.

Swiss authorities have uncovered a case of meat smuggling, with a total of 208 t of meat of unknown origin. The investigation took place in 2024 and is looking into the origin and route of the smuggled meat.

Turkey's Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry has updated the list of honey products that do not meet quality standards. The list includes several famous honey brands that have been found to be adulterated and contaminated.

Brazilian police have dismantled a factory producing counterfeit olive oil in the coastal region of São Paulo, Brazil. The operation was carried out after an investigation revealed the production and distribution of adulterated olive oil in the region. 17/03/2025 g1.globo

Italian police have seized 700 kg of food products without traceability and not suitable for consumption from a street vendor in Calabria, Italy. 16/03/2025 <u>quicosenza</u>

Italian authorities have carried out checks in Catania and detected several cases of fish without traceability, as well as other suspicious food products. Malaysian police have arrested two individuals attempting to smuggle 40 t of white rice. 17/03/2025 <u>thestar</u>

The egg shortage crisis in the United States has led to an increase in egg smuggling from Mexico. United States authorities have reported a surge in egg seizures at the border, even surpassing the amount of fentanyl seized. High egg prices in the United States have created a lucrative market for smugglers, who are taking advantage of the situation to illegally introduce eggs into the country.

United States Prepared dishes and snacks Misdescription/ Mislabelling/ Misbranding Brazilian authorities have seized over 40 t of counterfeit olive oil, equivalent to approximately 10 800 l, in São Paulo, and four individuals have been arrested in connection with the case, highlighting concerns over food safety and authenticity.

The Colombian police have seized over 20 000 bottles of adulterated alcohol in an operation against food fraud. The alcohol is believed to have been produced illegally and did not meet quality and food safety standards.

18/03/2025 <u>eluniversal</u>

The KwaZulu-Natal police in South Africa have seized a large quantity of counterfeit alcohol, valued at EUR 70 000, and dismantled an illegal alcohol factory. One suspect has been arrested in connection with the case.

18/03/2025 <u>citizen</u> <u>iol</u>

A criminal complaint has been filed in relation to the production and distribution of bread that does not meet safety and public health standards in Argentina. The complaint focuses on crimes against public safety and health, and an investigation has been launched to determine the responsibility of those involved.

19/03/2025 eldiariodelarepublica

Italian police have seized 11.5 t of Indo-Pacific octopuses at the port of Venice, Italy. The importer has been fined for the infraction, as the octopuses did not meet food safety standards and had not been declared correctly. 20/03/2025 ilgazzettino

Sri Lankan police have intercepted a truck carrying a load of low-quality tea, known as "refuse tea", which is believed to have been intended for sale in the market as high-quality tea. The load has been seized and the case is being investigated. 21/03/2025 island

Cambodian authorities have seized over 25 000 chicken eggs that were illegally imported from Vietnam. The seizure was part of an operation to combat food smuggling in the country. <u>khmertimeskh</u>

The Nigerian Customs Service has seized 3 832 bags of contraband rice within a month. The seizures were made at various entry points across the country and the total value of the seized rice is estimated to be substantial. 27/03/2025 premiumtimesng

Brazilian police have detained a truck driver who was transporting 2 000 bottles of wine without a tax invoice and 750 l of an olive oil brand banned in Brazil. The cargo was found in a truck that was traveling through the Santos region in the state of São Paulo. 28/03/2025 <u>g1.globo</u>
