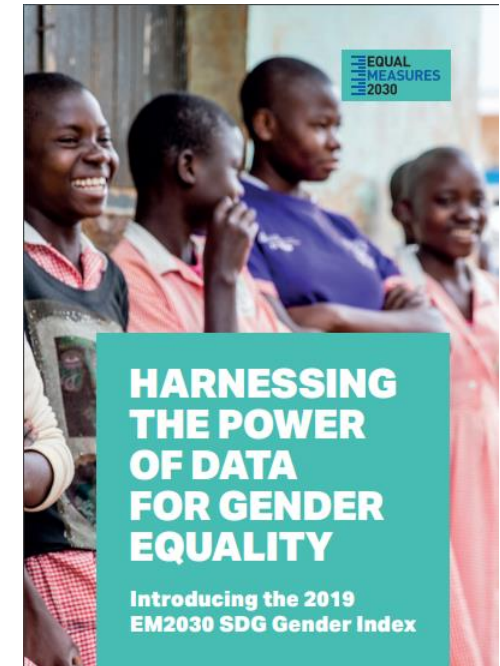
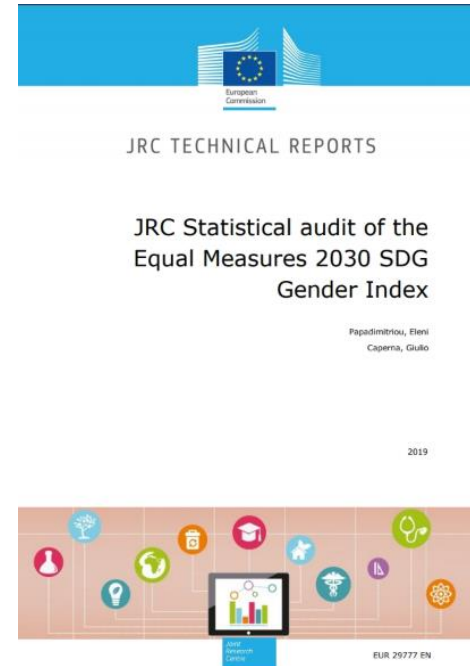

EM2030: connecting data and evidence to advocacy and action

- Understanding the gender policy space
- Understanding advocates priorities and information needs
- Direct support to grassroots civil society organisations
 - Providing demand driven system-level tools, like the SDG Gender Index and the gender advocates data hub (data.em2030.org)
 - Building capacity – skills training programmes from data to influencing
 - Providing tailored data support to achieve policy change



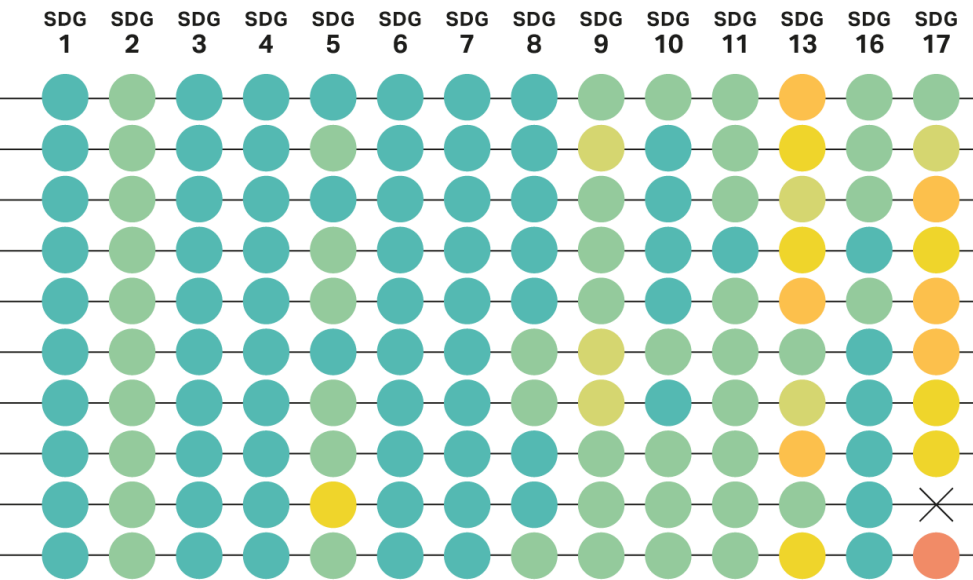
the USP of the SDG Gender Index

- Apply a **gender lens** across 14 of 17 goals
 - **Universal relevance** and **global coverage**
 - SDGs as a **normative framework** and **accountability mechanism**
 - Benchmarks **progress since 2015** – updated next in **2021**
 - Transparent / easy to communicate

- 129 countries and 95% of world's population of girls and women
 - Overall index scores **14** goals **51** indicators

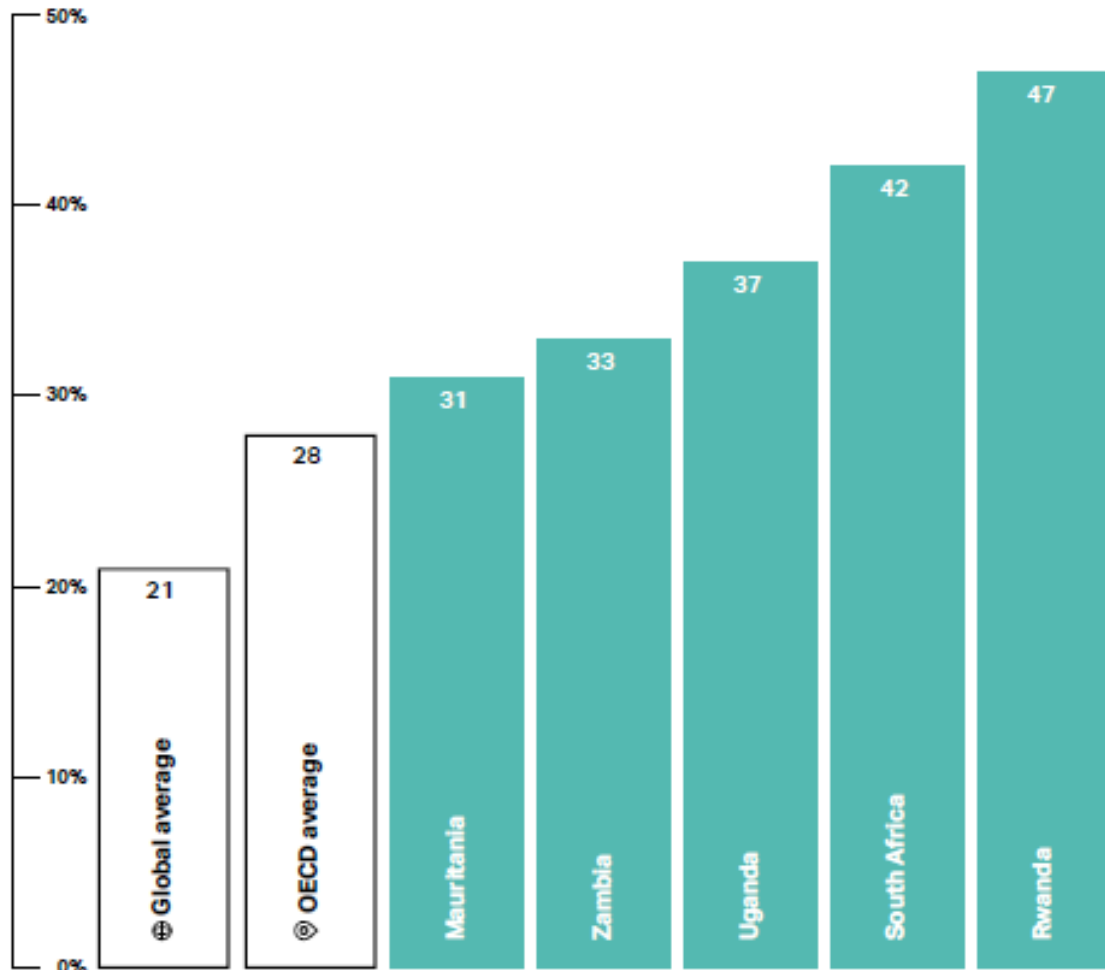
No country will achieve gender equality by 2030

1.4 billion or 40% of the world's girls and women live in countries that get a "very poor" score on gender equality

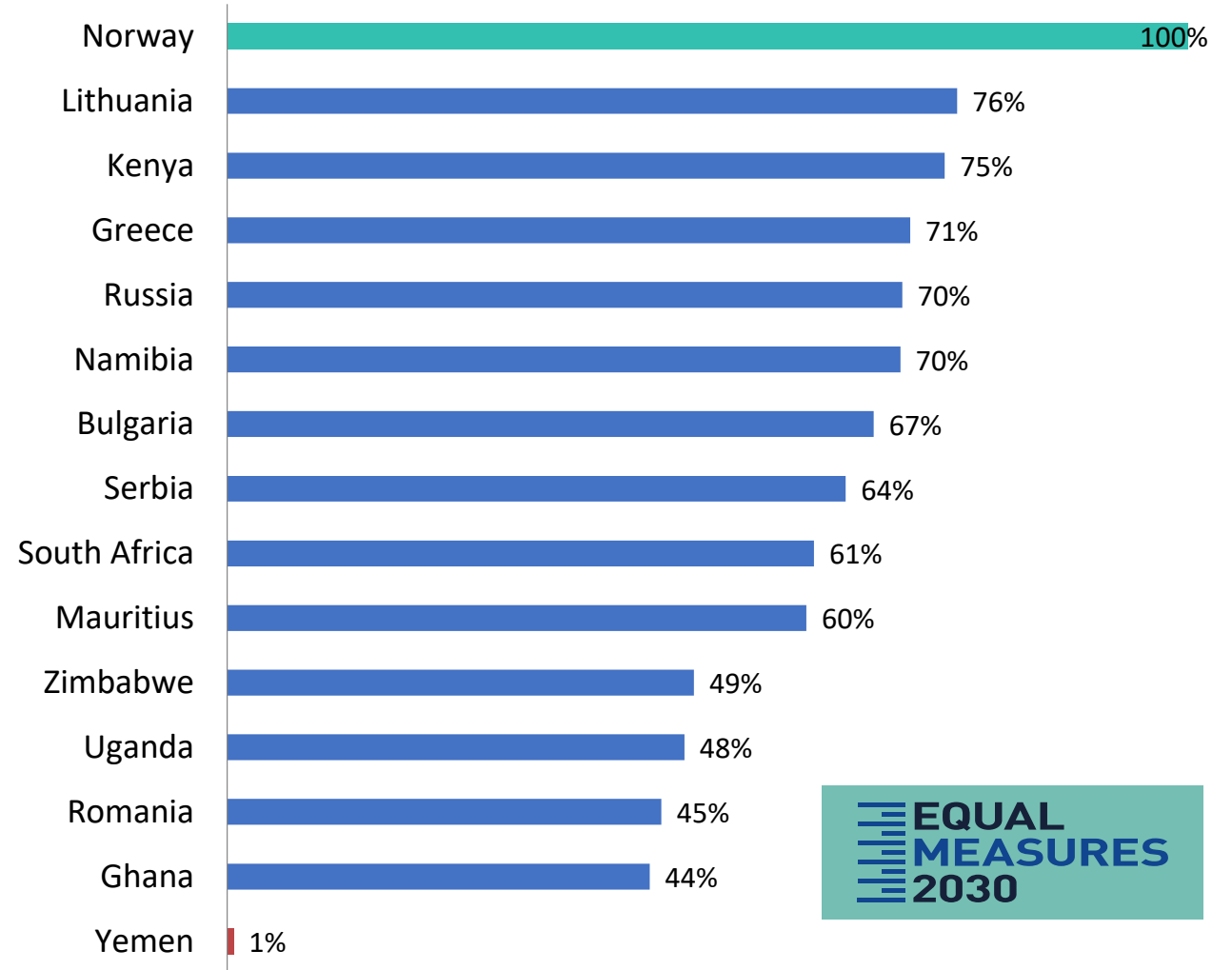
African countries perform well on gender equality in political participation and financial inclusion

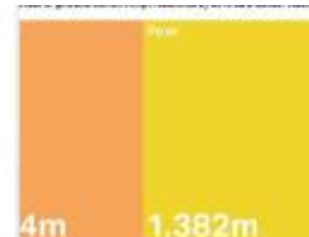

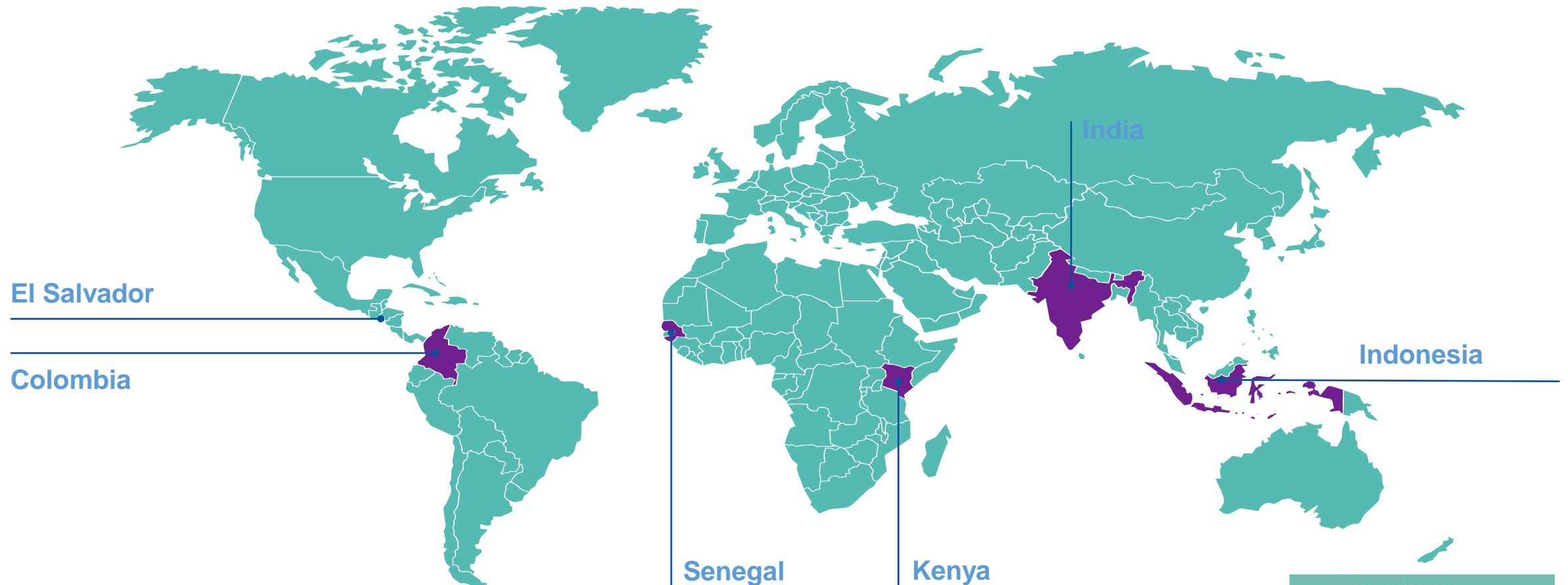

- Are we getting index and related data into the hands of local and national women's organizations?
- Are they effectively using that data in their advocacy?
- Are we supporting them to develop the data skills that they need?

how index is being used and its contribution to policy or advocacy initiatives at the national level

- 300 grass roots advocates trained on using the Index (and data) for advocacy
- Index used to frame national efforts to use data for influencing policy
 - Secondary education (Senegal)
 - Land security (Kenya)
 - Violence (India, Kenya)
 - Child marriage (Indonesia)
 - Access to SRH services (India)
 - Leadership/decisionmaking (Colombia)

how index is being used and its contribution to policy or advocacy initiatives at the global level

Global and regional policy platforms

- Beijing +25 declarations/political documents
- ICPD declarations and political documents
- Commission on the Status of Women - training advocates
- UN General Assembly / HLP Forum through VNR process

challenges faced when developing the index

- General pushback on another new gender index
- Consultation – enough is never enough – but can be enabled by strong partners
- Links to major events is essential
- Partnering with key information brokers
- Finding the sweet spot between
 - data availability and gender-relevant indicators
 - comprehensiveness and relevance to a specific policy issue/campaign/etc.
