# NetCIEx: research institutions with interest in CIE

- Multilateral CA started in July 2018
- Collaboration with university and other research institutions with an interest in CIE (Counterfactual Impact Evaluation)
- No money involved
- JRC can host Master students as atypical trainees and PhD students as visiting scientists
- Pros: you file the CA with the first partner; the next one just agree on the same terms and signs an accession letter
- Lighter workflow to approve new actions with a partner

Network partners: 5 Universities (1 extra-EU)

Events: One-day Workshop held in Ispra in Jan 2020

Visiting:

- 2021: 1 atypical trainee and 2 visiting scientists (forthcoming)
- 2020: 2 atypical trainees and 2 visiting scientists
- 2019: 1 visiting scientist

Publications (2020):

- 2 working papers, 2 technical reports
