TYPE OF INTERVENTION

Classroom education programmes and actions in school canteens, targeting pupils of primary and secondary schools

GOAL

Mon École Anti Gaspi" / "My School Against Food Waste" is an extensive programme designed to increase awareness of food waste. It provides teachers and primary school facilitators with educational tools that can be used and applied in classroom settings, extracurricular activities, and canteens.

IMPLEMENTATION AND EVALUATION

The programme offers free educational materials to teachers and activity leaders, which are available for download from the Too Good To Go website. It is entirely free, digital, and self-explanatory, designed in collaboration with education experts to ensure it aligns with the French school curriculum, thereby enhancing its relevance and applicability.

RESULTS

During the pilot phase of the intervention, approximately 600 school children benefited from the programme. However, as the intervention is currently being scaled up across France, it is expected to reach over 200,000 school children, significantly expanding its impact.
