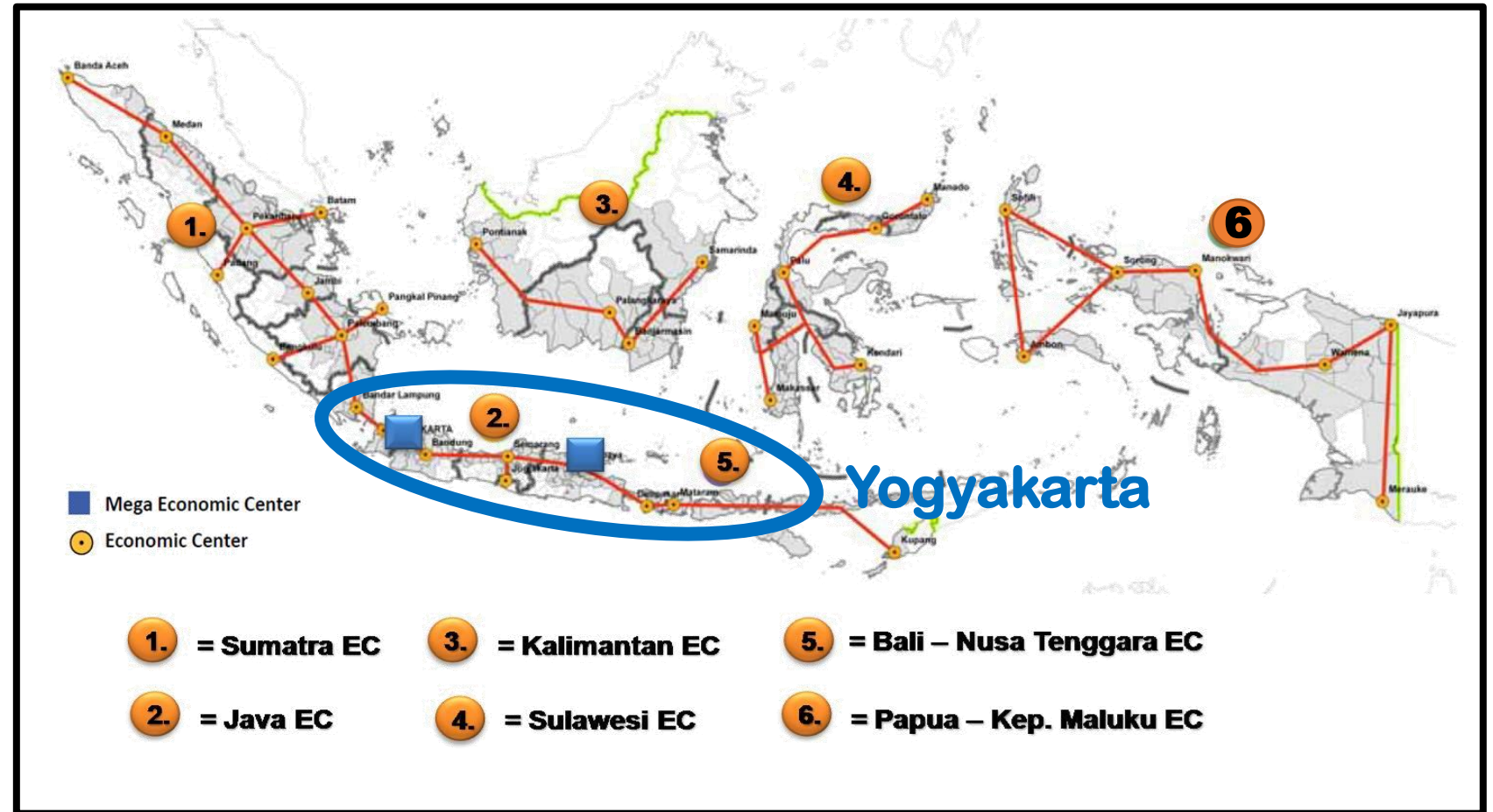

(LP11)*

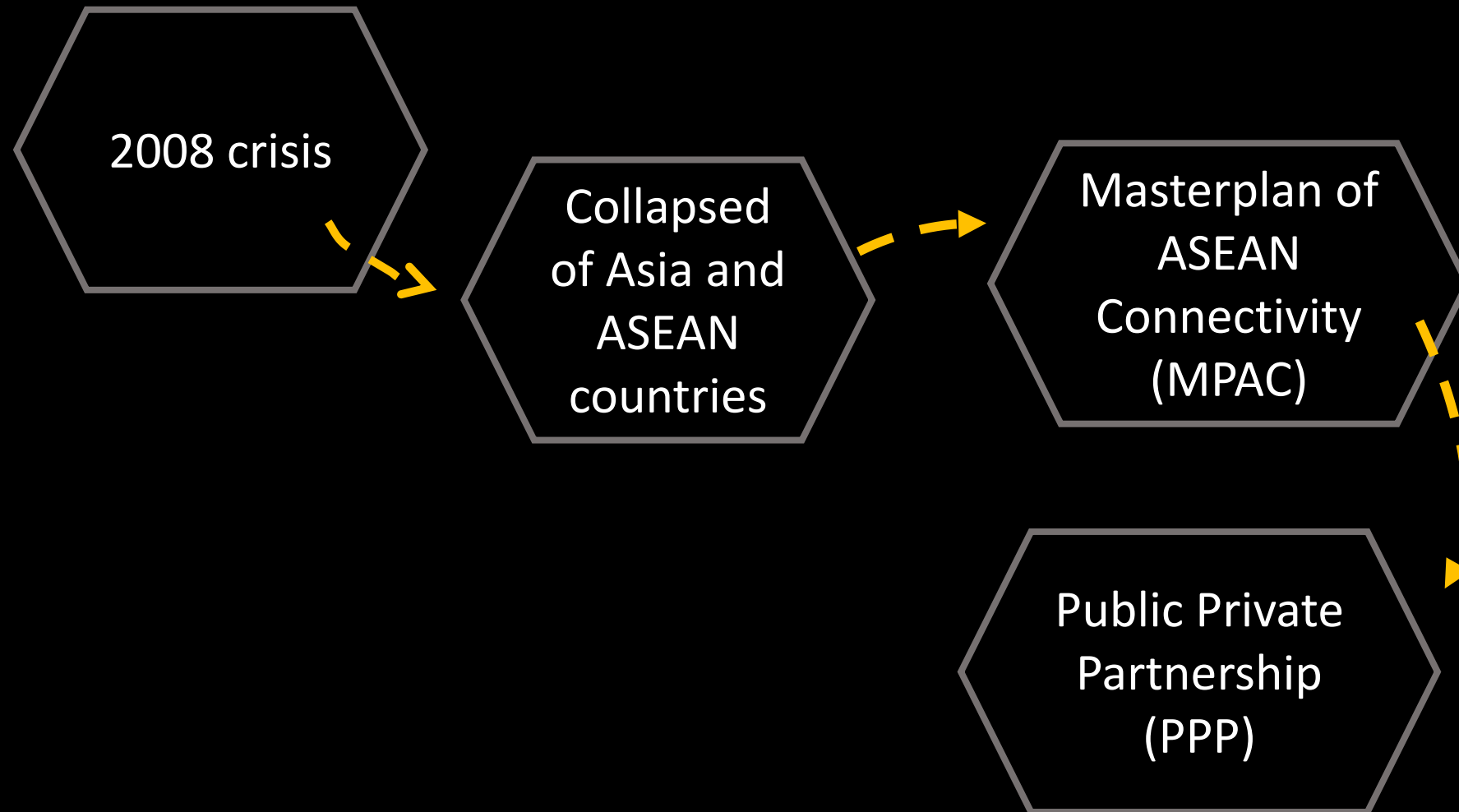

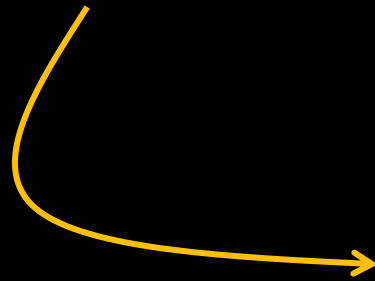
