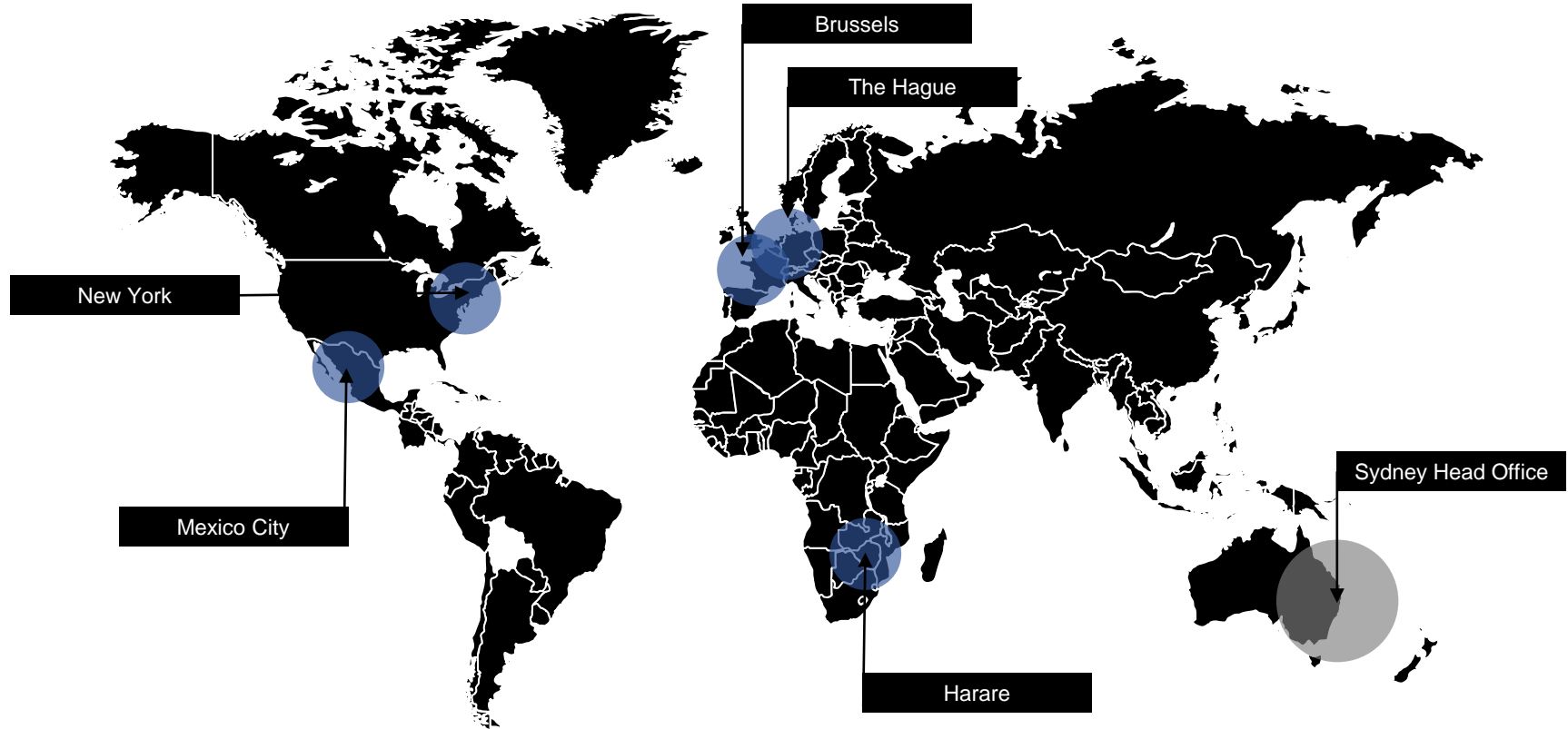

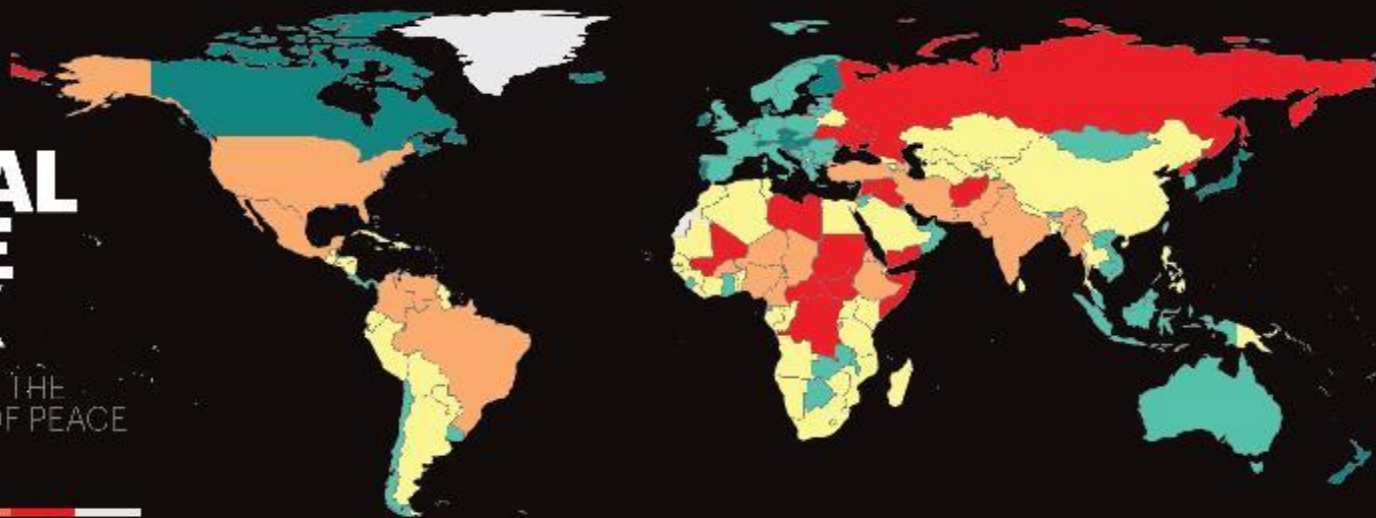

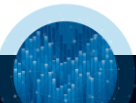
Positive Peace

Positive Peace creates the optimum environment for human potential to flourish.



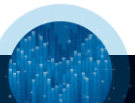
High levels of Positive Peace are associated with:

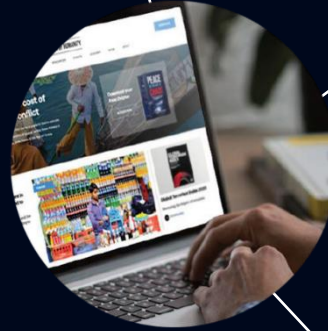
