


- The SDG Gender Index is Equal Measures 2030's flagship tool for advocates was first released in 2019
- The updated Index will be launch in March 2022
- The new design (COIN audit) covers
 144 countries and 56 gender issues
- It applies a gender lens to 14 development goals in the SDGs
- The updated index benchmarks countries' progress since 2015


The **EM2030 SDG Gender Index** is the most comprehensive tool available to explore the state of gender equality across the world

How have advocates used the SDG Gender Index:


- Framing advocacy issues for dialogue with governments

- Training youth advocates, data journalists (India, Kenya)









