

The authorities seized 7.5 tons of olives and 1 500 litres of olive oil without any traceability documentation. CivOnline

The authorities seized 35 in total tons of rice meant for the Public Distribution System (PDS). Uni India Times of India The Hindu

In the "Operation Matsu" the authorities (Civil Guard and Carabinieri) dismantled a criminal organisation taking canned tuna from the Italian market, relabelling them in unsanitary conditions and reintroducing the fraudulent products into the market with a new label, health registration and expiration date. In many cases (33/40) olive oil was in reality sunflower oil or pomace oil. The authorities also seized 45 000 litres of olive oil and 120 000 cans of tuna. Most of the preserved cans seized were intended to supply small businesses and large food chains in Spain and Italy mainly during the Christmas holidays. An investigation by the Direction générale de la concurrence, de la consommation et de la répression des fraudes (DGCCRF), carried out in 2019, revealed an anomaly rate of 29.5% in the butter chain. In total, 129 establishments were inspected and 89 laboratory

The Czech Agriculture and Food Inspection Authority (SZPI) analysed 21 samples of olive oil, identifying a non-compliance rate of 67% (14 out of 21). Some samples were mislabelled as "extra-virgin olive oil", stating a quality superior to the real one, or they presented deficiencies in the labelling. Food Safety News
