### Food Fraud Cases

Hong Kong customs officers seized almost 400 kg of cherries (total value of 8500 euros) counterfeited with the logo of a famous Tasmanian brand.

According to a scientific paper, about 20% of fish products sold in Taiwan are mislabelled. Most affected species include: snapper, cod and surimi. Such substitutions may constitute a health risk for consumers as well.

The Punjab Food Authority (PFA) discarded 4 000 litres of milk adulterated with water and detergents.

The "Mozzarella di Bufala Campana PDO" Consortium discovered hundreds of fake advertisements online related to their GI product, especially in the context of web marketplaces and e-commerce. According to the Consortium, one third of online advertisements are illegal, mostly in Italy but also in China and USA.
