

The Italian authorities seized a variety of products illegally sold by the same farm:

- 200 kg of fruits and vegetables mislabelled as "own production"
- 4 750 litres of common wine mislabelled as "Merlot" or "Cabernet", or counterfeited as the Geographical Indications "Vermentino" and "Ansonica"
- 11 000 litres of wine lacking any documentation (as e.g. traceability or origin)
