## Food Fraud Cases

The authorities seized in total 11.7 tons of red tuna lacking the required traceability documentation or without the Bluefin Tuna Catch Document.

In the operation “*Beluga*”, the authorities seized almost 1 ton of bivalves with fake packing dates or without traceability documentation.

In the operation “*Illegal Gear*”, the authorities seized 11 tons of seafood (including some red tuna, as mentioned in the above news) lacking the required traceability documentation.

In the operation “*BFT Connect*”, the authorities seized 1.5 tons of tuna and sea urchins without traceability documentation.

In the operation “*Controcorrente*”, the authorities dismantled a criminal organisation illegally fishing carps and catfishes by using banned methodologies (like electricity). The fishes were then smuggled to Romania with fake documents.

The authorities dismantled a criminal organisation faking horse and donkey certificates (e.g. passports, electronic chips) to divert and sell them as horse meat into the food chain. Horses and donkeys were originally not supposed to be farmed for human consumption (e.g. for horse racing).

Meat companies were accused of mixing mechanically separated meat into their poultry sausages without declaring it alongside the name of the product (as legally required), thus deceiving consumers. Laboratory analyses supported the suspicion.

In May, the Italian Carabinieri seized 700 tons of food unfit for human consumption, without traceability documentation or with wrong labels, for a total value of 3 million Euros. The controls focused on restaurants serving ethnic foods and cuisines, and the related supply chains.

The Italian authorities published the 2021 report on food adulteration. They performed 61 756 anti-fraud controls and inspected over 33 000 business operators and 62 000 products. The value of all products seized was 9.1 million Euros.

- the mislabelling of virgin olive oil for extra-virgin olive oil
- the mixing of olive oil with seed oils
- falsification of the country of origin
- counterfeit of Geographical Indications (GIs)
