Food Fraud Cases

The Directorate General for Competition, Consumer Affairs and Fraud Prevention (DGCCRF) published the 2020 survey on olive oil quality. DGCCRF carried out 206 inspections at 177 establishments, analysing in total 97 samples. More than a third of the establishments checked had anomalies, mostly concerning the absence or inadequacy of labelling information, substitution of olive oil with other vegetable oils, or wrong geographical origins. Almost half of the 97 samples taken were non-compliant in terms of organoleptic characteristics.

Rhodamine B is a cheap and unsafe red dye, thus being illegal to be used in food preparations. 2/10 samples of tomato sauce, 8/10 samples of chilli sauce and 7/10 samples of szechuan sauce showed the presence of Rhodamine B.

By using rapid immunoassay to detect 17 antibiotics on 699 animals, the authors found that 15% of analysed cattle actually tested positive for at least one antibiotic.
