OBJECTIVES: To share results of an ongoing capitalization and action-research work on the needs, challenges and potential solutions for transforming agricultural extension and advisory services (EAS) to better support agroecological transitions in West Africa. A policy brief on the levers to develop EAS for agroecology will be presented and discussed.
